

Education in the Health Professions Track (EHP)

The IDD M.S. program now offers education and training of healthcare professionals in the context of interdisciplinary and professional healthcare professions.

Competencies developed in the EHP track:

- Deliver effective interventions based on evidence-based practice
- Design and evaluate educational programs
- Apply current research to practice
- Develop and evaluate research projects
- Demonstrate leadership in professional practice
- Utilize various research methods

Program Structure

The EHP Track has a curriculum that is distinct from the traditional IDD curriculum. It includes coursework that is relevant to the health professions. Like the normal IDD M.S. program, most students complete their thesis work. The capstone project is a requirement for the program. The capstone project is a 30-credit requirement.
